New Board of Directors

At the Glen's annual meeting on November 9, 2011, the Board of Directors acquired two new members and, at a meeting immediately following the annual meeting, chose a new slate of officers:

The new **President** is **Ray Alexander**, the prior Board Vice President. The retiring Glen President, Kathy Clatanoff, and her husband have moved to Annapolis but are keeping their unit here in the Glen. Kathy has the distinction of having served as the Glen's second President in 1977, when our community was getting started.

Our new **Vice President** is **Amanda Derringer**, who was our prior Board Member at Large. She will continue to serve as our Landscape Committee Chair.

Newly elected Board member **Maynard Dixon** will be replacing long-time Glen activist Margaret Windus as **Treasurer**. Margaret has the distinction of having served, among many other capacities, as the Glen's third President in 1978-1979. Fortunately, Margaret will be sharing her vast knowledge of Glen affairs with the Board as an unpaid consultant (we could not afford to pay her what she's worth).

Newly elected Board member **Jay Yianilos** will be replacing Jonathan Rolbin as **Secretary** and is also replacing Maynard as publisher of the *Glen Echo*.

Board member **Jonathan Rolbin**, the prior Secretary, was chosen to serve the community as **Board Member at Large**, which will allow him to apply his skills to a wide variety of problems and issues.

Schedule of Monthly Fees for 2012

At the Glen's November 9, 2011 annual meeting, the budget was approved, and the following schedule of fees was adopted for 2012:

We have simplified the payment and administration of fees by rounding them to the nearest dollar. This will not cause a creeping shift in fee/ownership ratios because unrounded monthly assessments for each year will be computed based on ownership percentages in the Master Deed and will then rounded.

How to Pay Your Monthly Fee

For those who prefer to pay the old fashioned way — by monthly check — Cardinal Management Group will automatically send-out coupon books to owners who are not signed-up for direct debit of their accounts. You should be on the alert for them. Please do not mail checks to Cardinal without using the coupons in this book.

Residents who want to authorize Cardinal to directly debit their bank accounts for the payment of monthly fees may do so by filling out the form attached to this newsletter and mailing it to Cardinal Management with a voided check. As noted on this form, the direct debit authorization will remain in effect — and will be adjusted automatically by Cardinal each year to reflect changed fee levels — until you provide written notification of its termination.

Other residents may have automatic bill pay arrangements with their banks (without direct debiting by Cardinal). Residents should be alert to update these arrangements to reflect the new fee levels.

Recycling in Fairlington Glen

The following information on what and how to recycle was taken from the web site of Capitol Services of Virginia, at http://capitolservicesofva.com/recycling.html.

1. <u>Mixed Paper:</u> Newspaper, Magazines, Inserts, Office Paper, Brochures and Other Glossy Paper, Paper Bags, Self Adhesive Paper, Post-it Notes, Paper and Hardcover Books, Catalogs, Cereal and Food Boxes, Telephone Books, Envelopes (with and without windows), and "Junk Mail".

Do not recycle items contaminated with food, such as paper plates and napkins.

Remove liners in cereal and food boxes

- 2. <u>Cardboard</u>: Corrugated Cardboard, Pizza Boxes, and Flattened Cardboard Boxes.
- 3. <u>Commingles</u>: Aluminum Cans, Metal Food Cans, Glass Bottles and Jars, Milk and Juice Cartons, Plastic Bottles and Jugs (Recycling Nos. 1-7), Wide-Mouth Plastic Containers, Aluminum Foil, Aluminum Trays, Clamshell Containers, Empty Aerosol Cans, Wire Hangers, Rigid Plastics, Yogurt Cups, and Plastic Bags.

Empty and rinse all food and liquids from plastics, aluminum beverage and other metal cans (removing the label is unnecessary).

Do not recycle plastic food trays, light bulbs, mirrors, styrofoam, window glass, ceramics, batteries, pottery, cookware (pots and pans).

- 4. <u>Recycling Bins</u>: FOOD CONTAMINATION can cause an entire batch of commingled recyclables to be rejected by the recovery center.
- 5. <u>Collection:</u> Recycling service will be provided each week on your designated day or days for separated newspapers, cardboard and for commingles (see acceptable and non-acceptable materials above). Capitol Services will take all suitable materials placed in proper recycling bins to a recycling recovery center.

Note: In the Glen, recycling bins are placed in designated spots on Tuesdays for pick-up on Wednesdays.

Holiday Safety in the Glen

Throughout the year, but especially during the holidays, it's important to take preventative steps to just say no to crime.

If you are going to be out of town, please have a friend or trusted neighbor look after your home and property while you're away. It's important to have someone to pick up your mail or newspapers, grab any fliers that are on your door or porch, and also retrieve any packages that may have been delivered. If not, you could be alerting thieves that nobody is home.

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Also consider leaving lights on while you're away. And maybe ask your friend or neighbor to occasionally park in your space. All of these things will simply give the impression that you are home.

Always lock your car doors and never leave your car windows open. If you're out shopping, keep your bags, packages and other valuables in the trunk.

According to the Arlington County Police, the holidays typically show an increase in home burglaries, street robberies, and thefts from vehicles.
